 - -- need time to review and research to see if we can really drop the sales tax mark-up from 10% to 5%
 - -- 10% was originally established to cover the H&I expenditures on literature
 - -- the 10% currently covers only \$100 of the \$200 (or \$300) per month H&I budget.
 - -- Lower prices could encourage more groups to buy there literature at Area which may also increase the number of GSRs attending the ASC and making donations.
