

GPA BOD Report 2/27/2022

Attached is a copy of the last inventory that was performed on 8/24/2019 on the GPA storage facility.

I looked into storage facilities in the area and the estimated price range is as follows for small 5' \times 10' (\$87 to \$91), medium 5' \times 15' (\$96 to \$130) and large 10' \times 15' (\$159 to \$262).

I noticed that prices in Providence and Pawtucket tend to be approximately 23% more than places like Cranston or Warwick. Something to think about when we decide to get a storage unit.

All of the units I looked at were online, contact free so we can make auto payments through the checking account and also converse with the company via email.

Our recommendation is that we wait until we have something to put in the unit and then we can re-price and evaluate it then.
